Itinerary

Day 1 - 13 June 2021

Arrive Cairns. Group transfer from airport to hotel. Free evening, Pacific Hotel, Cairns.

Day 2 - 14 June 2021

CAIRNS - THURSDAY ISLAND - CAPE YORK

Transfer from your Cairns accommodation to Cairns airport for your flight to Horn Island. Transfer by ferry to Thursday Island and on arrival, you will be taken on an informative guided bus tour of the island and its picturesque Harbour, once home to the romantic

pearl lugger fleet. This afternoon board your ferry to the mainland, where you will be met by your guide, who will take you to Seisia. Seisia is ideally located for our next few days, being in walking distance from the Seisia Wharf, a famous fishing spot. Our accommodation at Seisia Holiday Park are cottages with ensuite facilities.

Day 3 - 15 June 2021

CAPE YORK

An unforgettable day! Stand at the very top of mainland Australia. We then visit Somerset (road conditions permitted), once the home of the legendary Jardine family and government outpost established in 1864. We have lunch on the palm fringed Anchorage Beach, which overlooks the Albany Passage. A walk on the beach will complete your day before returning to Seisia. Our accommodation at Seisia Holiday Park are cottages with ensuite facilities.

Day 4 - 16 June 2021

CAPE YORK - FRUIT BAT FALLS - BRAMWELL STATION

Southward bound, we cross the mighty Jardine River, stopping at Fruit Bat Falls for lunch. Relax, swim and enjoy this unique area with its enchanting waterfall. Travelling along part of the Old Telegraph Track, before we make our way to a 'true blue' Aussie cattle station, Bramwell Station - ensuite facilities.

Day 5 - 17 June 2021

BRAMWELL - WEIPA

A southerly run through the wilderness with all its varied landscapes to cross the Wenlock River. We head for the shores of the Gulf of Carpentaria and Weipa. This afternoon there will be the opportunity of a Wildlife Eco River Cruise or Bauxite Mine Tour (own expense). Your accommodation tonight has ensuite facilities.

Day 6 - 18 June 2021

WEIPA - MUSGRAVE

We continue south, stopping off at the picturesque Archer River, then on to the historic frontier gold town of Coen.

The afternoon finds us arriving at our overnight accommodation at the Old Musgrave Telegraph Station - ensuite facilities.

Day 7 - 19 June 2021

MUSGRAVE - LAKEFIELD NATIONAL PARK - COOKTOWN

After an early start, we head east towards Princess Charlotte Bay where we explore Lakefield National Park (road conditions permitted), a haven for the many birds and animals native to this area. Lagoons, billabongs, and wide river lakes are home to both fresh and saltwater crocodiles. Travelling on, we visit Split Rock, Aboriginal Rock Art, before arriving in the old gold port of Cooktown, where we visit Captain Cooks Landing, before settling in to our accommodation in Cooktown - ensuite facilities.

Sovereign Hotel, all meals included.

Day 8 - 20 June 2021

COOKTOWN - CAPE TRIBULATION - CAIRNS

The final exciting day has, unfortunately, arrived, but before returning to Cairns, we make our way south passing the

mysterious Black Mountain and the historic Lions Den Hotel. Traversing the jungle shrouded Bloomfield Track (road conditions permitted) we see where the 'rainforest meets the reef' at Cape Tribulation. We travel through the splendour of a World Heritage listed rainforest. A scenic drive along the Marlin Coast back to Cairns is a perfect way to complete your tour. Pacific Hotel Cairns, breakfast and lunch included.

Day 9 - 21 June 2021 Depart Cairns

After breakfast, group transfer to Cairns Airport. Breakfast included.
